#### Ralf Maxeiner – Calendar/Edgeo update – need for financial support/sponsorship

#### 1. Calendar:

- printing cost has increased from \$4000 to \$5000.
- Sponsorship brings in about \$1600 (\$100 each month and \$100 for each of the 4 educational pages). SMA gives \$500. Average annual profit of \$500-\$1000. Total over 8 years: \$8000 profit!!
- Some sponsors are both SGS and Calendar sponsors.
- Motion: Brian puts for motion that in the event of a shortfall in the calendar funding/revenue, the SGS will provide funds to make up the deficit. Dillon seconded the motion. Brendan questioned whether funding is set before going to print. Ralf confirmed that corporate sponsors are set in the spring (~\$2000). 300 calendars (@\$10 each = \$3000) need to be sold to break even.

## 2. Geoexplore:

• \$9000 funds from APEGS to develop website/app. About \$2000 left in budget. Need to update Quaternary section. Current format is largely for desktop. Mobile app would require significant funds (very expensive) but ESRI is constantly updating.

## 1. Education Outreach:

- Perhaps merge the Geoexplore committee with the Outreach committee as these two are similar

- Talk to Geoexplore Committee about the prospect of developing the mobile App. How much will it cost? What is the maintenance cost and level of effort to the committee? Is this something for which the SGS should seek funding.
- Luncheon talk costs are going way up. Consider increasing price from \$15 to \$20 dollars.
- Dillon motions to change luncheon talks to \$20 and \$10 for students. Dave seconds the motion. Motion passed.
