Saskatchewan and Northern Plains Oil & Gas Symposium

Early Bird registration commenced May 15th and we currently looking for corporate sponsorships and commercial exhibitors. You may register on-line or by downloading mail-in registration forms at www.sgshome.ca.

The Saskatchewan and Northern Plains Oil & Gas Symposium will take place in Regina during October 17th and 18th, with an associated core workshop on Monday October 16th, and an ichnology workshop by Dr. James MacEachern on Thursday October 19th. A field trip to the PCS Lannigan Potash mine will also be taking place on October 19th. Talks and poster displays will cover a wide-range of oil and gas settings including heavy oil, shallow gas, Paleozoic traps and also features such as regional fluid flow and the influence of basement structures on hydrocarbon trapping. The tentative agenda is posted on our website.

A Social Evening is planned for Tuesday, October 17th at the Saskatchewan Science Centre that will include food stations featuring different ethnic foods, access to interactive displays, IMAX movies, entertainment, telescope viewing opportunities and more, all as part of the general registration. In addition, the SGS will be publishing a hard-bound Proceedings Volume to be distributed at the outset of the symposium.
