## Saskatchewan and Northern Plains Oil & Gas Symposium

The Saskatchewan and Northern Plains Oil & Gas Symposium will take place in Regina during October 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, with an associated core workshop on Monday October 16<sup>th</sup>, and an ichnology workshop by Dr. James MacEachern on Thursday October 19<sup>th</sup>. A field trip to the PCS Lannigan Potash mine will also be taking place on October 19<sup>th</sup>. Talks and poster displays will cover a wide-range of oil and gas settings including heavy oil, shallow gas, Paleozoic traps and also features such as regional fluid flow and the influence of basement structures on hydrocarbon trapping.
